Peon

The applicants who will apply for the post of Peon and whose applications are found in order will be called for Written Test. The Written Test will contain 50 questions (Fifty marks) carrying 1 (one) mark in each question on Assamese, General English, General Mathematics, General Knowledge and Reasoning (10 marks in each subject). Qualifying marks in Written Test is 60% (50% in each subject). The qualifying candidates will be called for the Viva-Voce (20marks) in the ratio of 1:3 from the rank wise list of marks in the Written Test and Board reserves the right to fix the marks to be called for the candidates for viva-voce/interview in the ratio of 1:3. The final Selection list will be prepared on the basis of the sum total of marks obtained in Written test and Viva-Voce. Where more than one candidate obtain same grand total of marks (marks of Written test and viva-voce), the candidate who obtains more marks in the Written Test will be given preference. Where the marks obtained by such candidates in the Written test are also same, the candidate who is senior in age will be given preference. Where the marks obtained by such candidates in the driving test are also same, the candidate who is senior in age will be given preference.
